CARE OF YOUR WATCH

- This watch contains electronic components.
 Never attempt to open the case or remove the back cover.
- Do not operate push buttons below the surface of the water while swimming or diving.
- Should water or condensation appear in the watch, have the watch checked immediately.
 Corrosion of electronic parts can occur inside the case.
- 4. Avoid severe impact. The watch is designed to withstand impact under normal use. It is inadvisable to subject it to severe impact or rough usage.

(Battery: CR2032)

- ► HOLD S1 BUTTON, MONTH & DATE WILL DISPLAY.
- ► EL IS TURN-ON FOR THREE SECONDS WHEN S4 BUTTON IS DEPRESSED.
- ► WHEN S1,S2 AND S3 BUTTONS ARE DEPRESSED SIMULTANEOUSLY, LCD ALL-ON,EL-ON AND BUZZER-ON WILL OCCUR.
